APRIL PREVIEW

Les Richardson, President of Richardson Farms of White Marsh, will be our speaker on Thursday, April 11th. The company has farms as far north as Glen Arm and fields of vegetables right here in Bowley's Quarters, with its very successful Farmers Market and produce packing facility located on Ebenezer Road. Les will discuss 12 years of evolution, the impact of Covid on the business, and what's in store for the next 10 years.

MARCH MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

In the mid 1950's the Maryland Air National Guard (MDANG) came to Middle River. Col Richard Hunt, gave an overview of the 175th Wing as it is today with its 400 maintenance and 100 support staff mem-

bers. Since 2013, mission expansions have been addressing cyber security, joining up with Fort Meade's cyber intel operation to address computer network exploitation. The base has an amazing group of folks traveling back and forth to Europe addressing cyber issues. They provide federal cyber support and also cyber support to the State Board of Elections. They do extensive integration with our State partners, Estonia/Bosnia-Herzegovina as well. Col. Paul Kanning shared that the A-10s are deploying in a couple of days to the Middle East for ACE (agile combat employment). The MDANG at Martin State Airport strategic priorities are: Martin State



ject (Click on Final EA for Phase I Improvements at Martin State Airport (marylandaviation.com) for more information) the MDANG is a major stakeholder, but not in charge of the design, contract management, or funding. The project addresses the need for required safe flying areas as well as mission capabilities. Currently, there are trees and power lines impacting the 8100 ft of unobstructed runway that will need to be removed. By July the runway will be fully resurfaced. The question remains as to whether this renovation is timely enough to keep the A-10s here. Future Fighter Conversion—



can the runway support future flying missions? A-10's staying or F-35s possibly moving in? F-35 is a standard advanced fighter and would be the best aircraft to house here (but they are much louder).; **Expand Cyber and Intelligence Operations**- the current 500 positions supporting flying missions would be repurposed to address cyber needs. The floor was opened for questions and several in attendance voiced noise concerns about the F-35 possibility and asked for clarification with some of the runway renovation and expansion. With the MDANG priorities in mind, flying missions and cyber expansion hanging in the balance, and the question of how any of this could impact BQ living, discussion about the best

use of the Middle River MDANG will continue between the state and federal government as the runway renovation moves toward completed in 2026.




